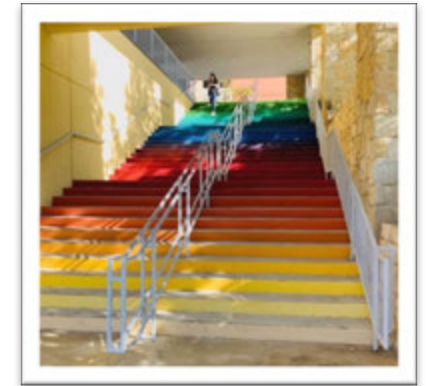
Next stop: **Mural located at Chico’s**, across from Cinemark
